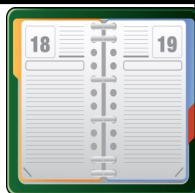
Accelerated Reading Scheme

This new scheme was set up in the school holidays by Mrs Robertson and Miss Mitchell and is a computerised scheme that puts every single book in the school (fiction and non-fiction) into reading bands according to ability. Your child/children have taken part in an online quiz this week in school that has then automatically told them which band of reading they are in. The children are then able to access books according to their level. At the end of reading each book, the children take part in an online quiz to make sure that they have read and thoroughly understood the book that they have read. If they get 70% or more in the quiz, they gain points which are logged into their online record. This scheme has been incredibly successful in other schools and we are hoping that it will enable to keep a track of your child's reading progress more effectively.

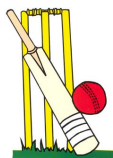
All the children have settled down really well to a new term and as ever we will expect the children to continue to behave well and try their very hardest at everything they do in school.
