### Bassenfell Residential

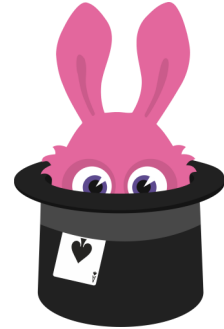
There is the possibility of a residential for KS2 to Bassenfell Manor some time in April 2018. More news next year!
